Archery

What is Archery?

Archery is the sport of firing arrows at set targets at varying distances

Tui Ridge Park has enough equipment for three targets and bows to be set up. However our normal set up consists of two targets and bows.

You are in good hands

In order to keep your costs down we are happy for you to look after your selves. Our qualified instructors will give your group leaders a thorough briefing on each step of instructing archery from introduction to gear and training of its use to finally "hitting the mark". Each instructor has been fully trained and is totally competent in every aspect of all the activities and procedures. For an additional cost Tui Ridge can provide an instructor for this activity.

What do I have to wear?

We advise sturdy shoes, relatively comfortable fitting practical clothes. Hats and warm jackets are recommended and a raincoat just in case as it can get cold at the park.

Food and Water

Taps with drinking water are close by the Archery site so you can fill up your drink bottles there if needed. Tui Ridge can provide lunches by request but must be booked prior to arrival.

Who can use it?

Any member of the public can hire our Archery gear on any day of the week except Saturdays and subject to booking availability. Prices will vary depending on group numbers and time required.

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ARCHERY PROCEDURES

This is an adult supervision activity

DESCRIPTION

Archery is the sport of firing arrows at a set target or targets from varying distances. Tui Ridge Park has one target stand that holds two targets and this is where any archery at Tui Ridge Park should be conducted.

GROUP RESPONSIBILITIES

Adults should make themselves familiar with how to do archery before activity begins

Adults must supervise activity at all times

A safe working ratio of 1 adult per 10 students should be maintained unless a Tui Ridge Park staff member is present during activity

Only two participants should be using bows at any given time

Each participant has four shots each

No arrows are to be collected until all arrows have been fired

All other participants must remain behind archers until it is their turn

The group will pay for any broken or lost arrows (this is above the cost of hire)

Group leaders are solely responsible for the safety and well being of all group members during activity

TUI RIDGE PARK RESPONSIBILITIES

Tui Ridge Park will supply all the necessary equipment for the activity

Tui Ridge Park staff will demonstrate the correct use of a bow and all possible hazards to group leader prior to activity

Tui Ridge Park will maintain all archery gear on a regular basis

Tui Ridge Park will check all archery gear prior to and after each day for any damage and repair as needed and charge accordingly

Emergency Action Plan

If someone is injured:

- Stop activity
- Locate group leader or Tui Ridge Staff member or host
- Leader or TRP staff member to assess injury and apply first aid if needed
- If injury is serious contact Ambulance services immediately
- Notify TRP host if not already done
- Assess if activity can continue

Instructor requirements

- Understanding of archery and risks
- Leadership skills

Pre activity check list

- Clear instructions given
- Make sure bows set up correctly and right number of arrows
- Targets used on target stands
